Chief Master Sergeant Justin M. Tite is the Chief Enlisted Manager of the 368th Training Squadron, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Chief Tite is the Senior Enlisted Leader and advisor to the commander on all matters impacting the professional development and readiness of the squadron, consisting of 127 military and civilian instructors, military training leaders, and curriculum developers who train, inspire, and develop over 1,500 Airmen per year. The squadron operates four technical training schoolhouses that provide ready Airmen and leaders to Civil Engineer Squadrons and Logistics Readiness Squadrons across the Air Force.

Sergeant Tite grew up in St. Louis, Missouri and entered the Air Force in August of 2005. His background includes Operations experience as an Aerial Gunner on Combat Search and Rescue Helicopters. He deployed to Operation IRAQI FREEDOM and Operation ENDURING FREEDOM in this role three times. Justin has also spent time in Professional Military Education while stationed at the Barnes Center for Enlisted Education. Sergeant Tite currently works in Civil Engineering as an Engineering Assistant. He deployed again in support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE with the 1<sup>st</sup> Expeditionary Civil Engineer Group. He has earned a Bachelor's degree in psychology, and a Master's in counseling - Military Resilience.
