MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Military Police Captains Career Course – Reserve Component Maximum Allotted Training Time and Course Design Considerations

1. The MPCCC-RC provides similar educational outcomes to the MPCCC (RA) in roughly the same amount of time as the former RC Officer Advanced Course and RC Combined Arms and Services Staff School. IAW AR 350-1, the MPCCC-RC now follows a 13 month model which includes two 15-day resident periods, and 11 months for completing branch specific DL phases. Officers have the flexibility to complete the DL at home station.
2. The MPCCC-RC resident phases as outlined in TRADOC Regulation 350-70 can be completed in a maximum of two active duty training periods across two fiscal years.
3. Training may be split into two 14 day periods within a 13 month window to allow multiyear funding.
4. IAW AR 350-1 the RC officers may enroll in the MPCCC-RC upon completion of BOLC and promotion to O-2. Those who desire to enroll prior to this time require a waiver by the unit commander, or by the Commander, HRC for members of the IRR. RC Officers must enroll in the MPCCC-RC prior to completing eight years of commissioned service.
5. Exceptions to the policy listed above will be granted on an individual basis. The Soldier's commander must submit a memorandum requesting an extension, with justification for the delay through command channels to the first O-6 in the Soldier's chain of command. This extension, if granted by USAMPS, may allow up to an additional 12 months.
