Admission Requirement:

- a. Participants must submit an application and be accepted to MSU before participating in the CWMD Cooperative Degree program.
- b. Bachelor degree from an accredited college or university approved by MSU and submission of an official transcript reflecting conferral of degree.
- c. Participants in this program will not be required to complete separate graduate entrance examinations such as Graduate Record Exam (GRE), Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT), or Miller's Analogy Test (MAT). Letters of recommendation are not required.
