

Natural Gas Safety and Awareness

In its natural state, Natural Gas is odorless. We add a harmless chemical odor to the gas, often described as smelling like rotten eggs. This smell is the Best way for you to detect a natural gas leak.

If you detect a strong smell of natural gas inside or outside your home, leave the area immediately. Do not create any sources of ignition, such as operating electrical switches, appliances, smoking, starting your car, or even using your telephone. From a safe location call the Fort Leonard Wood Fire Department at 911.

If you are planning a project that requires any type of excavation, you must first obtain an excavation permit from DPW Family Housing Branch. Examples would include installing a fence, flagpole, satellite dish, also landscaping, or any other activity involving digging. This process will allow Omega to locate and mark underground pipelines in the area of excavation.
