ATP 3-34.80	<i>Geospatial Engineering</i>	This publication will be updated to incorporate integration of geospatial engineering in support of multidomain operations at all echelons, with an added focus that describes geospatial engineering within brigades and divisions.	2d Quarter, FY 24
FM 3-34	<i>Engineer Operations</i>	This updated publication will contain the doctrinal guidance for U.S Army engineers. It will be aligned with joint and Army doctrine and constitutes the doctrinal foundation for developing other fundamental tactics, techniques, and procedures detailed in subordinate engineer publications.
