


► Online Resources

If you have a DoD ID number you can access numerous online resources, free to you. Visit <https://www.dodmwrlibraries.org> to check out what is available. All you need is your DoD ID number and birthdate in order to log in. There are business resources, DIY sites, education/research, e-learning, music and music videos through Freegal, movies and documentaries through Kanopy, genealogy, magazines, newspapers, and many resources for kids.

Tutor.com provides online tutoring and homework help for the U.S. military, Department of Defense staff, and their families 24/7. They can help with all core subjects and with essay writing.

You also have access to ebooks and audiobooks through the **Libby** app. To get started:

1. Download the **Libby** App
2. "Do you have a library card?" select **Yes**
3. Click **Search for a library**
4. Search **"Department of Defense"**
5. Click on **Sign in with my card**
6. Select **DoD MWR Libraries** from the list
7. Click **Next**
8. Provide requested information
9. Start Reading
