#### MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Garrison Policy 30, Use of Unit Funds

- 1. Purpose: To provide policy guidance regarding the use of Units Funds provided by Family and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Nonappropriated Funds (NAF) to support unit level programs and services.
- 2. Reference: Army Regulation 215-1 (Military Morale, Welfare, and Recreation Programs and Nonappropriated Fund Instrumentalities), 24 September 2010
- 3. Applicability: The guidance applies to all Fort Leonard Wood Military units receiving authorizations to execute authorized NAF issued funds for unit benefits.

### 4. Policy:

- a. All Military units are required to pursue MWR, AAFES and/or DeCA services and programs first when executing their NAF Unit Funds.
- b. In the event services and programs are not available, MWR, AAFES and/or DeCA operations and facilities will issue a Statement of Non-availability to the requesting unit(s). The Statement of Non-availability must be attached to the Military Unit's request for funds memo.
- c. Units cannot seek quotes from off-post vendors for goods or services until they have secured their Statement of Non-availability of services from MWR, AAFES and/or DeCA.
- 5. This policy supersedes any previous policies and is in effect until superseded or rescinded.
