REAL ID gate access policy

Beginning June 1, Fort Leonard Wood physical security specialists will no longer solely accept state-issued identification that does not meet the REAL ID Act of 2005 standards. Anyone with a non-compliant ID will need to provide a secondary form of identification, such as a U.S. passport or a certified birth certificate. DOD civilian retirees must present and register an acceptable credential, such as a REAL ID Act-compliant driver's license, and their retirement Standard Form 50 at the Visitor Control Center to facilitate future visits to the installation. Previously issued DOD Civilian Retiree ID Cards will remain valid through Aug. 31, and will not be reissued.

Fort Leonard Wood park gets rededication

The park, located near the intersection of Missouri and North Dakota avenues, was originally constructed in 1942, and stonework was added in 1945, by German prisoners of war. The rededication is occurring in two phases. Phase one included the new plaque and interpretive signs that have been added, celebrating Fort Leonard Wood's community support and heritage. The second phase, scheduled to be completed in 2024, will include the addition of a statue of General Leonard Wood on horseback and a compass rose monument.
