LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING BRANCH

The Law Enforcement Training Branch (LETB) develops the advanced technical and tactical capabilities of Department of the Army law enforcement professionals. Through a curriculum focused on accreditation, high-risk incident management, and advanced tactical proficiency, LETB ensures our law enforcement personnel are equipped to operate with confidence and precision in any environment.

LETB Course Details

Conservation Law Enforcement Officer Course



Develops the specialized capabilities required to enforce conservation law and protect natural and cultural resources on Army lands. The course equips law enforcement personnel with the unique field skills needed to operate effectively in remote environments and ensure compliance with federal environmental mandates.

Core Outcomes

- Proficiency in Federal conservation law enforcement (Sikes & Lacey Acts)
- Advanced skills in remote field operations and search & rescue
- Expertise in natural and cultural resource protection
- Enhanced inter-agency coordination with civilian law enforcement
- Competency in emergency field medical response

Course Overview

- Duration: 2 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident Course
- Annual Throughput: 30 students

Marksman Observer Course



Develops advanced capabilities for Marksman/Observer teams to support high-risk incidents and special security operations. The course provides expert training in overwatch protection, intelligence gathering, and precision fire, equipping commanders with elements skilled in providing inner perimeter control and decisive response.

Core Outcomes

- Mastery of inner perimeter security for high-risk incidents
- Advanced intelligence gathering and tactical application
- Highly accurate and effective precision fire delivery
- Enhanced decision-making for overwatch teams in complex environments

Course Overview

- Duration: 1 Week
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 120–150 students

Special Reaction Team Course



Develops advanced Military Police response capabilities for high-risk incidents that exceed the scope of routine patrol operations. The course equips commanders with highly trained tactical elements capable of executing precision responses in complex and time-sensitive environments.

Core Outcomes

- Advanced proficiency in close-quarters combat and urban operations
- Enhanced decision-making and critical thinking under stress
- Mastery of integrated breaching, mobility, and tactical coordination
- Precision marksmanship for high-risk incident resolution

Course Overview

- Duration: 2 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 420–480 students

United States Army Civilian Police Academy



Serves as the foundational career-field certification for Department of the Army (DA) Civilian Police Officers (GS-0083). This academy produces accredited, technically proficient officers who act as force multipliers for the Military Police Corps, fully prepared to execute law enforcement missions in compliance with DoD and Army standards.

Core Outcomes

- Mastery of foundational law enforcement principles, authority, and jurisdiction
- Proficiency in defensive tactics, use of force, and patrol operations
- Expertise in firearms handling, including day/low-light qualification
- Certified competency in emergency vehicle operations and first responder skills
- Accreditation by DoD POST, FLETA, and TRADOC

Course Overview

- Duration: 10 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident Only
- Annual Throughput: 210 students

INTEGRATED POLICING SOLUTIONS BRANCH

The Integrated Policing Solutions Branch enhances policing capabilities across the Army and War of Defense through premier, specialized training. This program equips law enforcement professionals with the critical skills needed to strengthen operational readiness, foster resilient communities, and effectively manage complex security challenges

IPSB Course Details

Advanced Police Administration Course



Develops expert administrators to manage the Army Law Enforcement Reporting and Tracking System (ALERTS). The course ensures the integrity of Army-wide law enforcement data by providing personnel with advanced skills in system management, data extraction, and quality control. As this course is fully funded by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), there are no travel or per diem costs for units.

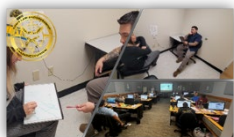
Core Outcomes

- Mastery of ALERTS user management and administrator roles
- Proficiency in data extraction for trend analysis and reporting
- Improved report writing quality and accuracy for case management
- Effective utilization of the Law Enforcement Management System (LSMS) and CODIS

- Annual Throughput: 300 students

Child Abuse Prevention and Investigative Techniques Course



Develops specialized investigative skills for sensitive and complex child abuse cases. The course prepares investigators to gather evidence, support victims, and operate effectively within the multi-disciplinary Family Advocacy Team. As this course is fully funded by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), there are no travel or per diem costs for units.

Core Outcomes

- Mastery of victim-sensitive interviewing and evidence collection techniques
- Effective collaboration within the multi-disciplinary Family Advocacy framework
- Proficiency in child abuse crime scene examination and evidence handling
- Comprehensive understanding of legal considerations and jurisdictional authority

Course Overview

- Duration: 2 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 200 students

Crime and Criminal Intelligence Analyst Course



Prepares law enforcement personnel to conduct certified analytical operations in support of Police Intelligence missions. Accredited by the International Association of Law Enforcement Intelligence Analysts (IALEIA), this course ensures practitioners can deliver timely, compliant intelligence that enhances protective services and supports mission success within the DoD framework.

Core Outcomes

- Proficiency in analytical techniques for Police Intelligence Operations
- Comprehensive understanding and application of DoDI 5525.18 and 28 CFR 23
- Enhanced capability to produce and disseminate actionable intelligence
- IALEIA-accredited analytical skills to support law enforcement and security missions

Course Overview

- Duration: 2 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 240 students

Critical Incident Peer Support Course



Develops the capability to manage combat and operational stress within military police formations. This course equips personnel with the skills to recognize stress indicators, facilitate crisis intervention, and establish effective peer support programs to preserve the force's health and welfare. As this course is fully funded by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), there are no travel or per diem costs for units.

Core Outcomes

- Proficiency in identifying and analyzing critical incident stress indicators
- Mastery of peer support intervention and crisis communication techniques
- Ability to implement and manage formal peer support programs
- Competency in delivering critical incident stress debriefings

Course Overview

- Duration: 1 Week
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 180 students

Domestic Violence Intervention Training Course



Prepares law enforcement and support personnel to effectively intervene in and investigate incidents of family dysfunction and domestic violence. The course focuses on a multi-disciplinary approach to protect victims, de-escalate volatile situations, and restore healthy family dynamics. As this course is fully funded by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), there are no travel or per diem costs for units.

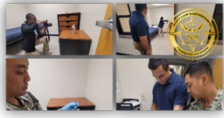
Core Outcomes

- Mastery of intervention techniques for domestic violence incidents
- Proficiency in specialized, victim-sensitive interview methods
- Expertise in collecting and preserving evidence in a domestic violence context
- Enhanced ability to identify abuse indicators and de-escalate volatile encounters

Course Overview

- Duration: 1 Week
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 432 students

Military Police Investigator Course



Develops foundational investigative capabilities for joint-force military and civilian law enforcement personnel. The course produces certified investigators skilled in resolving criminal activity at and below the felony level through comprehensive evidence collection, intelligence application, and proactive crime prevention.

Core Outcomes

- Proficiency in foundational criminal investigation techniques
- Mastery of collecting and processing physical and testimonial evidence
- Effective application of police intelligence and crime prevention strategies
- Competency in conducting thorough investigations to resolve criminal acts

Course Overview

- Duration: 8 Weeks
- Delivery: Resident Only
- Annual Throughput: 360 students

Structured Child Interview Course



Prepares criminal investigators and social workers to conduct structured, non-leading forensic interviews of children with the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) protocol, enabling personnel to elicit reliable, forensically relevant. As this course is fully funded by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD), there are no travel or per diem costs for units.

Core Outcomes

- Mastery of the NICHD Investigative Interview Protocol for children
- Enhanced ability to elicit reliable, forensically relevant information
- Proficiency in conducting developmentally appropriate, non-leading interviews
- Improved collaboration within the multi-disciplinary team (FAP/LE)

Course Overview

- Duration: 1 Week
- Delivery: Resident and MTT
- Annual Throughput: 96 students

OPERATIONS SUPPORT AND SUSTAINMENT BRANCH

The OSSB enables ALETD mission execution by synchronizing resources, infrastructure, and oversight across all training programs.

Core Functions

- **Training Management:** Oversees the complete training lifecycle, including course planning, execution, and performance evaluation to meet evolving requirements.
- **Resource Synchronization:** Aligns all necessary personnel, equipment, ammunition, and facilities to support the training schedule efficiently.
- **Risk & Medical Support:** Manages safety for high-risk training by conducting risk assessments, ensuring medical coverage, and controlling access to training areas.
- **Facility Management:** Maintains all instructional facilities to provide a safe and effective environment for training delivery

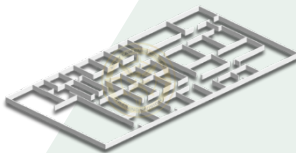
Training Area and Annex Facilities

ALETD maintains multiple certified facilities designed to support advanced law enforcement and high-risk training scenarios.



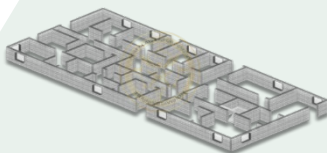
Training Area 167 Main

- Close Combat Mission Capability Kit (CCMCK) training.
- Fence breach sites.
- Certified for explosive breaching and stun grenades.



167 "C" Side – Active Shooter Facility

- Approx. 16,000 sq. ft.; CCMCK certified
- Modular interior, vehicle access, low-light capability
- Authorized for stun grenade employment



167 "B" Side – Multi-Purpose Facility

- Approx. 8,000 sq. ft.; CCMCK certified
- Multi-entry design with certified breaching points
- Full catwalk visibility

Law Enforcement Small Arms Facilities



This comprehensive complex for advanced live-fire and close-quarters combat (CQC) features dynamic ranges and certified breaching structures to ensure full-spectrum mission readiness. The facility is fully standalone and mission-capable, sustained by extensive support infrastructure to allow for uninterrupted, self-sufficient training cycles. A central O/C IRSO workstation provides command and control over all activities.

Live-Fire Range Capabilities

- Range: Variable distances from 3 to 200 meters.
- Lanes: 30 covered firing lanes, expandable to 60.
- Targets: Stationary, moving, and automated small arms targets (Types A-K).
- Certification: Pistol and rifle calibers up to 7.62mm.
- Scenarios: Supports use of vehicles, barricades, elevated firing positions, and other non-standard live-fire events.
- Additional Range: One (1) 25-meter covered square range.

Close Quarters & Breaching Facilities

- Primary Structures: Six (6) standalone buildings certified for Close Combat Mission Capability Kit (CCMCK) training.
- Shoot Houses: Two (2) 2,500 sq ft live-fire shoot houses (SH1, SH2).
- Breaching: Certified for both ballistic and explosive breaching tactics.
- Tactical Enhancements: Features multiple entry points and is authorized for stun grenade use.
