1. PURPOSE. To obtain 74D20 ICTL approval by the USACBRNS Commandant.
2. RECOMMENDATION. The Commandant approves the 74D20 ICTL.
3. DISCUSSION.
 - a. Upon the completion of the 74D AIT working group, the proposal was presented and approved by the CBRNS Commandant. This document addresses the ICTL portion of the proposed changes.
 - b. Remove and transfer the 9 tasks identified as higher level tasks to the 30 Level ICTL.
 - c. Remove Hazmat tasks and place a statement in the accompanying memo stating, "Hazmat Awareness, Operations, and Mass Casualty Decontamination will continue to be taught IAW the current course material managed by Functional Courses Branch". Therefore, eliminating the guesswork in determining which tasks are required for Hazmat Certification by the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC).

If the task is first trained to standard in the unit, the word “OP” will be in this column. If the task is first trained to standard in the training base, it will identify, by brevity code (S-D, INST), the resident course where the task was taught.
- **Sustainment Training Frequency Column** – indicates the recommended frequency at which the tasks should be trained to ensure soldiers maintain task proficiency.
- **Sustainment Training Skill Level Column** – lists the skill levels of the MOS for which soldiers must receive sustainment training to ensure they maintain proficiency to soldier’s manual standards.
