SUBJECT: Command Policy 5, Prohibited Relationships

1. REFERENCES.

a. AR 600-20 (Army Command Policy), 6 Nov 14.

b. TRADOC Reg 350-6 (Enlisted Initial Entry Training Policies and Administration), 7 Nov 13.

c. DODI 1304.33 (Protecting Against Inappropriate Relations During Recruiting and Entry Level Training), 28 Jan 15.

2. GENERAL.

a. Punitive. This policy is punitive. Failure to comply may result in adverse administrative action, or punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.

b. Applicability. This policy applies to all Service members permanently or temporarily assigned to, attached to, or otherwise present on Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

3. POLICY AND PROCEDURES.

a. In accordance with the above references, Fort Leonard Wood instructors, cadre, and permanent party Service members are prohibited from forming relationships with students/trainees unless those relationships are required by the mission. Relationships between instructors, cadre, or permanent party Service members and students/trainees that may be perceived as personal include, but are not limited to, shared living accommodations, dating, intimate or sexual relationships, and other nonprofessional social contact. This prohibition applies regardless of rank or grade. There are no exceptions.

b. Additionally, this policy prohibits certain types of conduct. Prohibited conduct includes, but is not limited to, writing personal letters, text messages, or e-mails; exchanging personal communications on social media; and having personal telephone conversations unrelated to the training mission. Attempting to establish a personal

relationship with a student/trainee through any means of communication is prohibited. Instructors, cadre and permanent party Service members are not permitted to contact, socialize, or otherwise interact with students/trainees outside of performing normal duty or training requirements.

c. There are no exceptions to this policy for pre-existing personal relationships.

4. SUPERSESSION. This policy supersedes all previous MSCoE and Fort Leonard Wood policies addressing fraternization and will remain in effect until rescinded or superseded.
