<u>Concealed firearm or weapon</u> : any firearm or weapon, as defined in FLW Reg 190-11, carried on or about the person or in a vehicle in any manner, which is concealed or does not allow immediate recognition of the weapon or firearm.						
Intent to go armed: the carrying of an instrument, implement, firearm, weapon, item or device with the knowledge that it is capable						
of being used and with the intent to use the instrument, implement, firearm, weapon, item or device for purposes of offense.						
<u>Weapon(s)</u> : Any firearm, compressed air gun, BB gun/BB pistol, starter pistol, paint ball gun, bow, slingshot, knife, bayonet, dirk, dagger, switchblade, brass knuckles, blackjack sap, nunchakus, bomb, grenade, explosive, incendiary device, saber, sword, spear, machete, or throwing star. However, a pocketknife with a blade of less than three inches shall not be considered a weapon, unless						
carried with the intent to go armed. Any instrument, implement, item or device when carried with the intent to go armed.
