The face-mask policy has been updated. Fully vaccinated Department of Defense personnel — 14 days after final dose — are no longer required to wear a face mask while indoors or outdoors here. DOD personnel will continue to comply with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidance regarding wear of masks in airports and taxis. Additionally, masks will be worn by DOD personnel in medical and dental treatment facilities. Anyone not yet fully vaccinated must continue to wear a mask inside installation facilities and outdoors when social distancing cannot be maintained.
