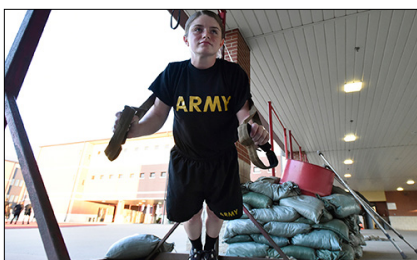
CBRN School announces Regimental Week events
