NOTES:

1. All uniform items will be serviceable IAW AR 670-1.
2. Identification tags will have the long and short chain, and allergy tags if applicable. ID tags will have the DODID number on them, not your social security number!! ID tags will be worn with all uniforms while on duty and will only be worn around the neck!!
3. During winter months (Oct - Apr) 1 pair of gortex boots will replace 1 pair of summer boots. Boots will be AR 670-1 compliant.
4. Students may bring spandex (black or gray) for wear under the APFU shorts. Boxers will not be worn with the APFU uniform. (Spandex will not be worn while conducting height and weight procedures).
5. All BLC students will verify authorized awards are reflected on their STP prior to attending the course. Students and their first line supervisors need to verify wear of any unit awards, combat service strips and combat service badges prior to reporting. Soldiers and first line supervisors need to verify the proper fit and wear of the Army Service Uniform prior to reporting to the course.
6. Glasses are not considered eye protection, only APEL approved eye protection with inserts is authorized.
7. 2 x three magazine pouch is authorized in lieu of the 3 x two magazine pouches. If bringing the Tactical Assault Panel (TAP) then you do not need to bring any additional magazine pouches.
8. All students attending BLC are encouraged to bring business casual attire, at least one set, business casual to include button down or collared shirt, slacks or khaki pants and appropriate footwear (tennis shoes and ASU dress shoes are not business casual).
9. Seasonal items are required from 1 October - 30 April.
10. We recommend all TDY Soldiers show up with basic toiletries. Students will have access to all AAFES facilities for the duration of the course.

I acknowledge that the items listed in this packing list have been laid out and inspected prior to arrival at the BLC. Furthermore, I understand that if any deficiencies are annotated during the initial layout of this equipment, I will have no more than 72 hours from the time of the initial layout to fix the deficiency, or be recommended to the Commandant for dismissal from the BLC IAW the approved Course Management Plan (CMP) dated September 2019. Lastly, I confirm that I have a CAC card with a working pin and am able to access my military email account.
