MEMORANDUM FOR Engineer Basic Officer Leader Course Students

SUBJECT: EBOLC Packing List

1. The following are the items required for all students to have prior to the start date EBOLC: (\*\* indicates optional items) (\* indicates winter items OCT-APR)

**A. Formal Uniforms.**

Army Service Uniform (ASU) or Army Green Service Uniform (AGSU)

Black bow tie (ASU)

Standard necktie (male) or neck tab (female)

Long sleeve dress shirt

Socks, black - 2 pair

Low-quarter shoes - 1 pair

Belt and buckle, brass - 1 each

Engineer Buttons sewn on NLT 30 days after arrival to B/554

\*\* All weather coat (not required, but recommended for winter months 1SEP-1MAY)

\*\* Females MUST bring both the ASU skirt and pants

\*\* Females MUST bring both low quarters and pumps

**B. Duty Uniform.**

OCP ACUs, either all sewn on or all velcro – 4+ sets (w/ 4 complete sets of patches)

Brown T-shirt - 6 each

Socks, OD/tan/black (Army issue) - 6 pair

Boots, coyote combat - 2 pairs (recommend one broken-in pair) do not bring cold weather boots to summer classes

Belt, Tan 2" nylon web - 1 each

Gray, Black, or Green APFU Leather Gloves

Ear Plugs w/ case ACU patrol cap w/ rank (subdued) and name tape

Coat, cold weather, ACU (either cold weather jacket)

\*\* Gortex / Gen III Cold Wet Weather (Gortex may or may not be issued at CIF, recommended that you bring your own if you have one)

**C. Improved Physical Fitness Uniform (IPFU).**

Shorts - 3

Short sleeve shirt - 3

Long sleeve shirt - 3

Jacket - 1

Pants - 1

\*\*Printer (not mandatory but will be very helpful)

\*\*Re-sealable storage bags (quart/gallon size)

\*\*Backpack/book bag, Military in color no logos or emblems.

\*\*M16 Cleaning Kit

Civilian clothing (remember, you do not have a lot of space)

Duffel Bag - 1 each

2. All students will participate in a formal banquet and must wear ASU or AGSU. All uniforms will be IAW AR 670-1 and DA Pam 670-1.
3. You will be required to have an extra rank and name tape to put on your improved outer tactical vest (IOTV) issued from CIF.
4. Students will receive a CIF issue but are encouraged to bring additional issued cold weather gear or any other FTX equipment and supplies needed (ie: camelback, map cases). If you have been issued a camelback in the past, you must bring it, if you are not sure if it is on your clothing records and you have a camelback, bring it anyway.
