

ATSE-DEB MEMORANDUM FOR Engineer Basic Officer Leader Course Students SUBJECT: EBOLC Packing List

1. The following are the items required for all students to have prior to the start date EBOLC: (** indicates optional items) (* indicates winter items OCT-APR)

A. Formal uniforms: Army Service Uniform Black bow tie Black tie Long sleeve white dress shirt Socks, black - 2 pair Black low-quarter shoes - 1 pair Belt and buckle, brass - 1 each Engineer Buttons (See attached A) ** All weather coat (not required, but recommended for winter months 1SEP-1MAY) ** Females **MUST** bring both the ASU skirt and pants **Females *MUST* bring both low quarters and pumps B. Duty uniform: ACU's (both the OCP and UCP are authorized for wear until the wear out date for the UCP) - 4 sets minimum (w/ 4 complete sets of patches) Tan T-shirt - 6 each Socks, OD tan/green/black (Army issue) - 6 pair Boots, tan combat - 2 pairs (recommend one broke in pair) do not bring cold weather boots to summer classes Belt, Tan 2" nylon web - 1 each Black or Green APFU Leather gloves Ear Plugs w/ case (worn on first belt loop on the left side of pants) ACU patrol cap w/ rank (subdued) and name tape Coat, cold weather, ACU (either cold weather jacket Helmet band with name Camelback **Gortex (Gortex may or may not be issued at CIF, recommended that you bring your own if you have one) **Green fleece w/ US and name tag if worn as outer garment (Green fleece may or may not be issued at CIF, recommended that you bring your own if you have one)

c. Improved Physical Fitness Uniform (IPFU) Shorts – 3 Short Sleeve shirt - 3 PT long sleeve shirt – 3 *mandatory for winter months 1 SEP- 1 MAY* (**summer months) Winter APFU - 1 set Green or Black fleece PT cap Running shoes - 1 pair (NO TOE SHOES!!!!) Authorized PT Gloves

D. Other: **Toiletries** Brown army towel Brown army wash cloth Five subject note book Scientific Calculator (Not a graphing calculator) Map pens, permanent (alcohol pens fine tip) Flash light (with red lens) *Polypropylene Long underwear (Tops and Bottoms) *Silk Weight Long underwear (Tops and Bottoms) *Generation III Cold Weather Undergarment (Waffle Top/Bottom) **Laptop **Printer **Re-sealable storage bags (quart/gallon size) **Backpack/book bag, Military in color no logos or emblems. **M16 Cleaning Kit Civilian clothing as desired (remember, you do not have a lot of space) Duffel Bag - 1 each

2. All students will participate in a formal banquet and must wear ASU.

3. You will be required to have an extra rank and name tape to put on your interceptor body armor (IBA) issued from CIF.

4. Students will receive a CIF issue but are encouraged to bring additional issued cold weather gear or any other FTX equipment and supplies needed (ie: camelback, butt pack, map cases). If you have been issued a camelback in the past, you must bring it, if you are not sure if it is on your clothing records and you have a camelback, bring it anyway.

ATTACHMENT A

You will be issued a complete set of TA-50 upon arrival at EBOLC, but you may or may not be issued Gore-Tex, polypropylene. You will be conducting several Field Training Exercises (FTX) regardless of weather, it is highly recommended that you bring extra cold weather undergarments (Military Issue) if you will be on FLW between OCT and APR. Read AR 670-1, Appendices B-E (page 330), which tells you which uniform items you are required to have/purchase.

The beret is worn during graduation, ACU patrol cap is worn for daily training and outdoor practical exercises.

ENGINEER SCHOOL PATCH: ALL STUDENTS regardless of follow-on assignment or component will wear the U.S. Army Engineer School patch (shown below). If you can't get one of these at your current location, contact the Fort Leonard Wood Military Clothing Sales at (573) 596-0131 ext 6-1502 for assistance. Patch must be either OCP or UCP color depending on which uniform you wear.



ENGINEER BUTTONS: All students, regardless of component, are required to have engineer buttons on their ASUs.
