


DAY 1: RIVER RUN FINISH LINE PARKING














DAY 2: North Gate to HELOCAST












Day 2: Helocast

DAY 2 PHASE 2: 24 APRIL 2022


0800-1800: Sapper Stakes


DAY 3 Phase 1: 25 APRIL 2022
