MEMORANDUM FOR Students Reporting to the Advanced Law Enforcement Training Division (ALETD).

SUBJECT: Reporting Instructions for ALETD Training Courses

1. Once Students arrive to Fort Leonard Wood they will report to Candlewood IHG for room assignments.

a. Address for Candlewood IHG is 4990 Nebraska Avenue, Building 2020, Fort Leonard Wood, MO 65473, 573-586-4800.

b. Address for Parker Hall is 7507 Artillery Circle, Building 971.

c. **Protective Services Training Course** (PSTC) report to Parker Hall at 0630 with all required paperwork. (See attached map for directions)

d. **Special Reaction Team Training Course** (SRT) and/or **Special Reaction Team Marksman Observer** (SRT MO) report to Range 14 BLDG 5540 at 0615 with all required paperwork and training equipment. (See attached map for directions)

e. **Antiterrorism Evasive Driving Course (AEDC)** report to TA 210 at 0700 with all required paperwork. (See attached map for directions)

f. **Note:** Information in this paragraph is subject to change pending restrictions and any updates to local COVID-19 policies.

2. Breakfast is not scheduled in ALETD courses Students will eat breakfast prior to reporting time. Dining Facilities (DFAC) hours of operations and locations are listed in attached enclosures.

3. Inclement weather reporting instructions call the Fort Leonard Wood SNAIR hotline at 573-563-4141 or go to the Fort Leonard Wood – Maneuver Support Center of Excellence home page at https://home.army.mil/wood/index.php Check middle of the web page and ensure that "Current News and Events" tab is highlighted. For Fort Leonard Woods current "SNAIR Report" click on "Current Weather Information" within the "Current News and Events" tab. This course and instructors are not considered essential personal if there is a delay.

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4. All Students are required to bring the following:

a. The requirement for a negative COVID test result, prior to arrival, has been rescinded. A negative test is NOT required for entry into this course. Students will be screened each morning prior to training. If students show signs or symptoms of COVID-19 further screening will be conducted by a medical provider. A positive COVID test during a course may result in quarantine and/or dismissal.

b. Military/DoD Identification card. Ensure Common Access Card (CAC) has been activated by your appropriate Human Resource section for meal card access. Government dining facilities are available seven days per week for personnel residing on installation and meals are centrally funded by the government.

c. Welcome letter.

d. Black pen and paper.

e. Two (2) copies of orders DD Form 1610 and amendments.

f. Required packing list items.

g. Assigned lodging building number, room number, and telephone number or off post hotel information.

h. Waiver(s) approved by USAMPS Director of Training and Education (DOT&E) (as applicable).

i. Copy of Profile. For course specific profile requirements see ATRRS or USAMPS website.

j. Copy of Law Enforcement weapons Training and Qualifications (LEWTAQ) pistol qualification within six (6) months or other service equivalent.

k. Soldiers: Provide copy of current MEDPRO medical readiness profile which confirms Army physical examination and PHA policy compliance. Physical must be conducted within 12 months of attending training.

I. **Other Services**: Provide copy of current medical readiness profile which confirms service physical examination compliance. Physical must be conducted within 12 months of attending training.

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m.**Civilians**: Provide copy of the medical profile or documentation of medical clearance to participate in strenuous physical activity. Physical must be conducted within 12 months of attending training.

n. Any student not in possession of the aforementioned documentation during in processing may be denied enrollment into the course.
