Packing List (As of 12 Jan 22)

- Military Issue Combat Uniform to include approved service boots. Additional Seasonal clothing (rain gear, cold weather gear, etc.) as needed (training lasts three weeks and is conducted outside for most of the course) Note: The Advanced Combat Shirt is authorized for wear during the course. Long Sleeves mandatory
- Military issue head gear (I.E. soft cap)
- Full fingered leather/nomex/combat gloves
- Service issued and approved ballistic wrap around eye protection (from the Authorized Protective Eyewear List (APEL) with clear and tinted lenses/inserts for eye corrections)
- Service issued Concealable body armor is required to bring. The Vest: Level 2A Concealed body armor should not interfere with drawing a pistol from a concealed configuration. If Student does not have concealable body armor, there is a limited amount of FoCBA and/or less concealable body armor that may be issued, but exact sizes are not guaranteed.
- Students with any special medical conditions that require special medication or eyewear are required to have it on their person at all times while attending training. (I.E. Bee sting kit, etc.) Note: The students are responsible for informing the course cadre of any such medical conditions during in-processing.
- Rigid duty belt capable of holding holster and magazine pouches.
- ID card
- Pen and notebook
- Groin protection (athletic cup)
- Water Source
- Slacks and sport jacket (one set), worn during final practical exercise
- Civilian Physical fitness clothing
- Casual attire: serviceable jeans, slacks, t-shirt, etc., worn during two days of evasive driving
- Soft soled shoes: worn during two days of evasive driving (no cowboy boots or ridged hiking boots)
