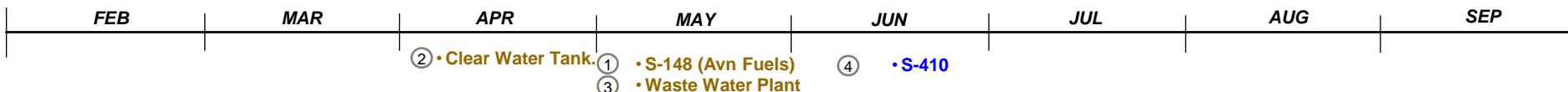

Personal Transportation Devices (PTD)

USFK Regulation 190-1 states:

- Personnel operating a PTD must pass the standard motor vehicle driver's licensing test and receive a USFK PTD Operator's permit or a separate endorsement for PTD operations on their USFK 134EK.
- All personnel wishing to operate a bicycle or PTD on a USFK roadway, street, bicycle path, or other right-of-way must register their PTD in DBIDS.
- Service Members wishing to operate a PTD require counseling and endorsement by a member of their chain of command as designated by the service component prior to being issued a USFK PTD Operator's Permit.
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required when operating a PTD.

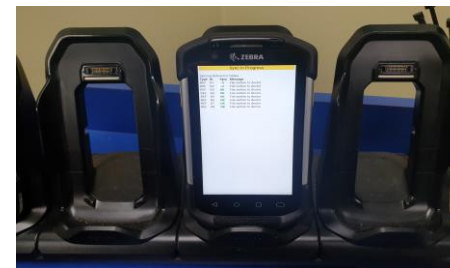
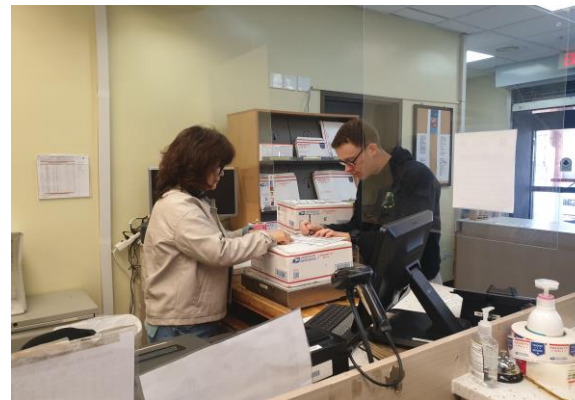

• Automated Military Postal System (AMPS):

- Delivery download issue causing redundant AMPS email notifications
- Issue is systemic throughout DoD organizations using the Military Postal Service Agency (MPSA) program

• Global Trade Compliance (GTC) in CONUS:

- USPS has stepped up enforcement GTC and returning Parcels that contain vague item descriptions
(Example: Toys = Legos, Barbie Doll, Toy Car)
(Example: Clothing = T-Shirts, Pants, Socks, Sweater)
(Example: Electronics = TV, Computer, Monitor)

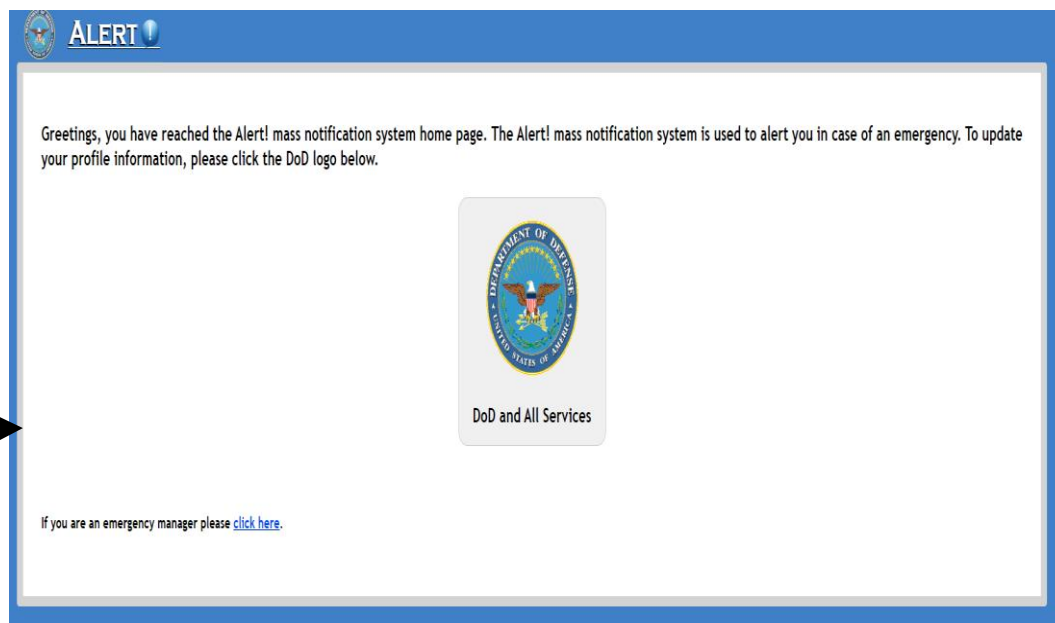
